## QUIZ FORMAT

Participating teams (comprising of 4 persons) will compete in either the **NOVICE** or **PREVIOUS ENTRANTS** categories. The competition is a table quiz format (no individual questions). The winning team from each category will be offered a place at the All - Ireland Finals on Saturday 18th March, 2026 at 2pm, Cavan Crystal Hotel, Co. Cavan and represent NISG against the NISO Regions.\*

## HOW DO YOU ORGANISE A TEAM ?

Speak to colleagues about the quiz, post this flyer on your notice board with your contact details, arrange an in-company quiz or contact your Safety Manager/ Officer/ Advisor.

## ENTRY CRITERIA FOR NISG QUIZ:

### Novice Category:

Teams may include individuals who:

- Have never participated in the competition before;
- Have not participated in either category of the quiz for the past 5 years;
- Have previously competed in only the Novice Category but not won the NISG competition or participated in the All Ireland Finals.

### Previous Entrants Category:

This category is open to teams who do not meet the criteria for the Novice Category.

\*only top scoring teams from NISG member companies will be eligible to represent NISG in the All Ireland Finals.

## FURTHER INFORMATION

- Teams will be asked questions on various H & S topics and some general knowledge questions.
- There will be up to 10 rounds of team questions.
- You can (and are encouraged) to enter more than 1 team up to a maximum of 4 teams per organisation.
- In both the **NOVICE** and **PREVIOUS ENTRANTS** categories the table quiz will determine the prize winning positions and the top 3 teams will receive personal prizes.
- Any team found to contravene the rules will risk expulsion from the competition.
